

- ARROWFLIGHT 3rd Edition Errata -

P12 – **Harkiloni** have a human lifespan (up to 100 years)

P15 – **Montaka** have a life expectancy of 80 years. Montaka native to Dara Tova or Fetak'Da'al speak Solander as their default language.

P29 – **Language** skill, *Empire* listing should read *Raihar*, and *Dark Lands* region should read *Fetak'Da'al*.

P30 – **Mechanical** is missing from the arcane theories listing.

P59 – **Knockdown, Death, and Dismemberment** - callout has SAVE in all caps in reference to the derived stat from previous editions. The syntax stands, however.

P61 – Ammo cost is incorrect. Price is accurately listed in the commerce section on p180.

P63 – **Drowning/Suffocation** - description has SAVE in all caps in reference to the derived stat from previous editions. The syntax stands, however.

P74 – **Healing** spell *Amplify Strength* should read: *The range is touch, and don't forget to apply the altered STR to VITALITY, as appropriate.*

P88 – **Rune** effects table, *Decrease* should read: *Target shrinks by 50%; loses half STR (round up).*

P92 – **Calling on Chaos**, second paragraph should read: *For each Wound Level that the mage takes, he gains his VITALITY in additional points to his MANA for the casting of that spell.*

P92 – **Example callout** should read: *He agrees to take 1 Wound Level of damage, which gives him his VITALITY 4 as a casting bonus (+4 to his MANA for the casting of this spell)...If Nazim had chosen, he could have taken 2 Wound Levels (Light Wound) and has twice his VITALITY (+8 to his MANA for casting the spell), and the area within 40 meters would be at -8 MANA and take eight weeks to fully heal.*

P156 – **Ghost** listing - *Soul Drain* should read: *Every successful attack made by the ghost means the target has lost a point of either MANA or SPIRIT.*

P166 – **Poltarch** listing should read: *Because their bodies are not living, they have no wound penalties or VITALITY, and do not make wound saves; they instead have Damage Points.*

P182 – **Dragon Skin Armor** listing “*absorbs one success in damage*” - reference is an artifact from an earlier system. Ignore.

P195 – **Mass Combat & Arrow Fodder** - second column references the SAVE derived stat from previous editions, but the point stands that nameless hordes of baddies do not get a wound save.
